The application process: a summary

18th Nov 2009	Sixth Form Open Evening. A chance to hear about the school, tour the site, meet key staff, find out about courses and receive the admissions criteria and application form.
4th Dec 2009	Deadline for return of the completed application form (known as the Supplementary Information Form or SIF) and Certificate of Religious Practice to the Admissions Officer at the school. The SIF asks questions related to our admissions criteria. It does not ask the student to provide us with any decisions at this stage about their proposed course of study.
Nov 2009 to Jan 2010	The student thinks about what subjects they would like to study in the sixth form.
Jan 2010	The student and their parents are invited to attend a personal consultation at the school, to discuss their ideas about what they would like to study. Please note that: each course has a upper and lower limit on the number of places so that we can maximise achievement by controlling the size of the teaching group; certain courses require particular GCSE grades, as described in our course booklet; it is not always possible for schools to timetable a particular combination of subjects.
Mid Mar 2010	Conditional offers are made to successful applicants.
Late Mar 2010	Return date for acceptance of conditional offers.
Aug 2010	Places confirmed on notification of required GCSE results.
