



## Message from the Headteacher

Dear Parents

We are very proud to announce an outstanding first set of GCSE results this summer. 50% of the grades were A\*- A; 87% pupils achieved 5 or more grades A\*-C; 84% pupils achieved 5 or more grades A\*-C including English and mathematics.

Yavneh College was consequently placed 13<sup>th</sup> in *The Times* league table of top non-selective and partially selective schools.

When this cohort entered Yavneh College as our first Year 7 in 2006, the CATs tests predicted that only 68% of them would achieve 5 or more GCSEs at grades A\*-C. To have gone on to achieve 87% is a remarkable outcome and is a testament to the excellence of teaching at Yavneh College and the hard work of the pupils.
