

THE MATHEMATICS DEPARTMENT

All of the members of the Mathematics Department are qualified mathematics teachers. The department occupies a suite of six large classrooms, each well-equipped with storage for books and other resources.

Every teaching room in the school is equipped with a ceiling-mounted data projector connected to a computer, DVD player, speakers and visualiser. Two of the mathematics classrooms are equipped with interactive whiteboards. An ICT suite is located adjacent to the maths classrooms.

The department is fully stocked with all necessary equipment, text books and software. There are detailed schemes of work, incorporating homework and assessment tasks, designed to challenge all pupils.

THE MATHEMATICS CURRICULUM

KS3 AND KS4 MATHEMATICS

The department uses MyMaths for KS3 and Edexcel GCSE Maths, all published by Oxford University Press.

GCSE results have been consistently outstanding with an average of just below 90% of pupils achieving A*-C, and over 90% consistently making expected progress.

Summer 2018 results were yet again outstanding with an average of 90% of pupils achieving 9 - 4, and over 90% consistently making expected progress.

Each year a small group of exceptionally able pupils in KS4 also study the FSMQ in Additional Mathematics OCR 6993, with consistently excellent outcomes.

A LEVEL MATHEMATICS


Mathematics is an extremely popular A level and the results are exceptional. Last year 67% of students achieved an A*/A in mathematics, 94% achieved an A*/B. In further mathematics 83% achieved an A*/A, 100% achieved A*/B.

Year 12 and Year 13 students follow the new Edexcel specifications, 9MA0 for A-level mathematics and 9FM0 for A-level further mathematics.

THE DEPARTMENT

There are currently 5 full-time and 2 part-time mathematics teachers. The staff within the department are supportive, friendly and are always willing to help.
